

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# **Employment legislation in 2022**

What to expect in 2022:

Implementation Date	Legislation
30 March (public sector) & 4 April (private sector)	Gender Pay Report
1 April	The Health and Social Care Act 2008 (Regulated Activities) (Amendment) (Coronavirus) (No. 2) Regulations 2022
1 April	National Minimum Wage
1 April	Trade Union Act 2016
6 April	Statutory Sick Pay
6 April	Statutory redundancy pay
6 April	National Insurance increase
11 April	Statutory rates



# **Employment legislation in 2022**

- Gender pay report:
  - Private and sector organisations must publish their gender pay gap reports, which focus on the 12 month period
- The Health and Social Care Act 2008 (regulated activities) (amendment) (coronavirus) (no.2) Regulations 2022
- National Minimum Wage
  - £9.50 (aged 23 years +)
  - £9.18 (aged 21 to 23)
  - £6.83 (aged 18 to 20)
  - £4.81 (aged 16 to 17 and apprentices)



# **Employment legislation in 2022**

- Trade Union Act 2016
- Statutory sick pay
  - £99.35 per week
- Statutory redundancy pay
  - £ to be announced in February (currently £544 per week)
- Statutory rates
  - SAP, SMP, SPP, SSPP, SPBP
  - £156.66 per week
- National Insurance increase of 1.25%
- 2022 Bank Holidays

Employment Bill	<ul> <li>New body to enforce NMW breaches and Modern Slavery</li> <li>Workers to receive tips in full</li> <li>Right to request a more predictable contract</li> <li>Extend current rights that are in place for pregnant workers</li> <li>Neonatal leave</li> <li>Unpaid carers leave</li> <li>Right to request FWR from day 1 of employment</li> </ul>	
Police, Crime, Sentencing and Courts Bill	<ul> <li>Reducing the time for certain convictions to be spent so they are not automatically disclosed on employment checks</li> <li>Changes not to apply to convictions relating to serious sexual, violent or terrorist offences where the sentence was 4+ years</li> </ul>	
Professional Qualifications Bill	New framework for recognising qualifications overseas	
Public sector exit payments – clawback	Prevent some public sector employees from keeping exit payments when they return quickly to the same area	
Sunday trading – protection for shop workers	<ul> <li>Duties on employers to notify employees of their rights about Sunday working</li> <li>Extend the rights of shop workers to opt out of Sunday working relating to additional hours under the contract</li> </ul>	
Bill of Rights	Would replace the Human Rights Act 1998
